LOCAL EXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES SERVICE GUIDE

This service guide contains the description, regulations and rates for the furnishing of services and facilities for resold and facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services provided by NOS Communications, Inc. with principal offices at 4380 Boulder Highway, Las Vegas, Nevada 89121. This service guide applies to detariffed intrastate local exchange service furnished within the State of Ohio. This service guide is in conjunction with NOS Communications, Inc.'s Tariff No. 3 on file with the Ohio State Public Utilities Commission.

The local exchange services in this service guide are detariffed, pursuant to Docket No. 06-1345-TP-ORD, by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

APPLICATION OF SERVICE GUIDE

This service guide supplements NOS Communications, Inc.'s ("NOS" or "Company") Local Exchange Tariff No.3, currently on file with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") sets forth the service offerings, rates and terms and conditions of service applicable to the furnishing of local exchange telecommunications services which have been detariffed by the Commission by NOS to Customers within the State of Ohio.

SECTION 1 - TECHNICAL TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS

1.1 Definitions

Authorized User – A person, firm or corporation which is authorized by the Customer or joint user to be connected to the Service of the Customer or joint user, respectively.

Automatic Numbering Identification – A type of signaling provided by a local exchange telephone company, which automatically identifies the local exchange line from which a call originates.

Business Day – The period of time from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, as measured by local time at the location from which the Call is originated.

Busy Hour – The two consecutive half hours during which the greatest volume of traffic is handled in the central office.

Call – A completed connection between the Calling and Called parties.

Calling Station – The telephone number from which a Call originates.

Called Station – The telephone number called.

Carrier – An entity, other than the Company, that provides telecommunications service.

Commission – Ohio Public Utilities Commission .

Company – NOS Communications, Inc., unless specifically stated otherwise.

Customer – A person, association, firm, corporation, partnership, governmental agency or other entity, including affiliates or divisions of the Customer, in whose name the telephone number of the Calling Station is registered with the underlying local exchange company. The Customer is responsible for payment of charges to the Company and compliance with all terms and conditions of this service guide and/or Company's tariffs.

Disconnect – To render inoperable or to disable circuitry thereby preventing outgoing and incoming telecommunications service.

SECTION 1 - TECHNICAL TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS (Cont'd)

1.1 Definitions (Cont'd)

Exchange – The geographical area that has been established to administer and furnish communications in that area.

Exchange Service – Service that involves furnishing central office facilities to provide users with the ability to make calls within the local service calling area on a measured or unlimited use bases.

Foreign Exchange Service – Service that involves furnishing central office line facilities to provide users with the ability to make calls within the local calling area on a measured or unlimited use bases.

Incomplete – Any Call where voice transmission between the Calling and Called station is not established.

Interruption – The inability to complete calls due to equipment malfunctions or human errors. Interruptions shall not include, and no allowance shall be given for service difficulties such as slow dialtone, circuits, busy or other network and/or switching capacity shortages. Nor shall interruptions include the failure of service or facilities provided within this service guide or tariffs by the Company shall not apply where service is interrupted by the negligence or willful act of the Customer, or where the Company, pursuant to the terms of this service guide or tariffs, terminates service because of non-payment of bills, unlawful or improper use of the Company's facilities or service, or any other reason covered by this service guide or its tariffs or by applicable law.

Holiday – For the purposes of this service guide recognized holidays are New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

LATA – A Local Access and Transport Area established pursuant to the Modification of Final Judgment entered by the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in Civil Action No. 82-01102; or any other geographic area designated as a LATA in the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. Tariff F.C.C. No. 4.

Measured Charge – A charge assessed on a per-minute basis in calculating a portion of the charges due for a completed interexchange or local call.

SECTION 1 - TECHNICAL TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS (Cont'd)

1.1 Definitions (Cont'd)

Message – A completed telephone call by a Customer or User.

Message Toll Service – A service involving facilities for telecommunications between local calling service areas.

Non-Business Day – The period of time from 4:01 p.m. to 8:510 a.m., Monday through Friday, and all Saturday and Sunday, as measured by local time at the location from which the Call is originated.

Normal Business Hours – The hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

Premises – The space occupied by an individual Customer in a building, in adjoining buildings occupied entirely by that Customer, or on contiguous property occupied by the Customer separated only by a public thoroughfare, a railroad right of way, or a natural barrier.

Rate – Money, charge, fee or other recurring assessment billed to Customers for services or equipment.

Recurring Charges – The monthly charges to the Customer for services, facilities and equipment, which continue for the agreed upon duration of the service.

Service – The Company's intrastate regulated telecommunications service.

Service Commencement Date – The first day following the date on which the Company notifies the Customer that the requested services or facility is available for use, unless extended by the Customer's refusal to accept service which does not conform to standards set forth in the Service Order or the service guides and tariffs of the Company, in which case the Service Commencement date is the date of the Customer's acceptance. The Company and Customer may actually agree on a substitute Service Commencement Date.

Service Order – The written request for network Services executed by the Customer and the Company in the format devised by the Company. The signing of a Service Order by the Customer and acceptance by the Company initiates the respective obligations of the parties as set forth herein and pursuant to this service guide and the tariffs of the Company, but the duration of the service is calculated from the Service Commencement Date.

SECTION 1 - TECHNICAL TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS (Cont'd)

1.1 Definitions (Cont'd)

Shared – A facility of equipment system that can be used simultaneously by several customers.

State – State of Ohio, unless otherwise noted.

Telecommunications – The transmission of voice communications or subject to the transmission capabilities of the Service, the transmission of data, signaling, metering, or other similar communications.

Terminal Equipment – Telephone instruments, including pay telephone equipment, the common equipment of large and small key and PBX systems and other devices and apparatus, and associated wiring, which are intended to be connected electrically, acoustically, or inductively to the telecommunication system.

User or End User – Customer or any authorized person or entity that utilizes the Company's services.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

2.1 Undertaking of the Company

- 2.1.1 The Company provides facilities-based and resold local exchange telecommunications service to Customers for the direct transmission of voice, data and other types of telecommunications.
- 2.1.2 The Company is responsible for the services provided under this service guide and for unregulated services provided pursuant to contract, and it assumes no responsibility for any service (whether regulated or not) provided by any other Carrier to the End User or to any carrier that purchases access to the Company network.
- 2.1.3 The Company installs, operates and maintains the communications services provided herein in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this service guide. When authorized by the Customer, the Company may act as the Customer's agent for ordering access connection facilities provided by other carriers or entities to allow connection of a Customer's location to the Company's network. The Customer shall be responsible for all charges due for such service arrangements.
- 2.1.4 The Company's services are provided on a monthly basis, unless otherwise stated in this service guide. Services are available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week.
- 2.1.5 The Company's customer service representatives for billing and service inquiries may be reached, toll-free, at 800-772-4667. Customers wishing to communicate with the Company in writing may send correspondence to: 4380 Boulder Highway, Las Vegas, Nevada 89121.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.2 Limitations of Service

- 2.2.1 Service is offered subject to the availability of facilities and provisions of this service guide.
- 2.2.2 Service is furnished to the User for any lawful purpose. Service shall not be used for any unlawful purpose, nor used in such a manner as to interfere unreasonably with the use of service by any other Users.
- 2.2.3 The use of the Company's services without payment for service or attempting to avoid payment for service by fraudulent means or devices, false or invalid numbers, or false calling or credit cards is prohibited.
- 2.2.4 The Company's services may be denied for nonpayment of charges. Additionally, the Company's services may be denied for noncompliance with any of the Commission's regulations, or for other violations of the terms and conditions set forth in this service guide.
- 2.2.5 The use of the Company's services to make calls which might reasonably be expected to frighten, abuse, torment, or harass another is prohibited.
- 2.2.6 Service temporarily may be refused or limited because of system capacity limitations.
- 2.2.7 Service is subject to transmission limitations caused by natural (including atmospheric, geographic or topographic) or artificial conditions adversely affecting transmission.
- 2.2.8 Service to any or all Customers may be temporarily interrupted or curtailed due to equipment modifications, upgrades, relocations, repairs and similar activities necessary for proper or improved operations.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.3 Limitations of Liability

- 2.3.1 Because the Company has no control of communications content transmitted over its system, and because of the possibility of errors incident to the provision and use of its service, service furnished by the Company is subject to the terms, conditions and limitations herein specified.
- 2.3.2 The Company is not liable to Users for interruptions in service except as set forth in Section 2.5 of this service guide.
- 2.3.3 The liability of the Company for errors in billing that result in overpayment by the Customer shall be limited, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, to a credit equal to the dollar amount erroneously billed or, in the event that payment has been made and service has been discontinued, to a refund of the amount erroneously billed.
- 2.3.4 The Company shall not be liable for and the User shall indemnify and hold the Company harmless against any claims for loss or damages involving:
 - 2.3.4.A Any act or omission of: (i) the User; or (ii) any other entity furnishing service, equipment or facilities for use in conjunction with services or facilities provided by the Company;
 - 2.3.4.B To the extent permitted under the MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16, interruptions or delays in transmission, or errors or defects in transmission, or failure to transmit when caused by or as a result of acts of God, fire, flood or other catastrophes, war, riots, national emergencies, government or military authorities, strikes, lock-outs, work stoppages or other labor difficulties, or causes beyond the Company's control. Customer credits shall apply to acts and occurrences not exempt from the application of Customer credits for service interruptions under MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16;
 - 2.3.4.C Any unlawful or unauthorized use of the Company's facilities and services;
 - 2.3.4.D Libel, slander or infringement of copyright or trademark arising directly or indirectly from content transmitted over facilities provided by the Company;
 - 2.3.4.E Infringement of patents arising from combining apparatus and systems of the User with facilities provided by the Company;

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.3 Limitations of Liability (Cont'd)

2.3.4 (Cont'd)

- 2.3.4.F Claims arising out of any act or omission of the User in connection with service provided by the Company;
- 2.3.4.G Breach in the privacy or security of communications transmitted over the Company's facilities;
- 2.3.4.H Changes in any of the facilities, operations or procedures of the Company that: (1) render any equipment, facilities or services provided or utilized by the User obsolete; (2) require modification or alteration of such equipment, facilities or services; or (3) otherwise affect use or performance of such equipment, facilities or services except where reasonable notice is required by the Company and is not provided to the Customer;
- 2.3.4.I Defacement of or damage to the Customer's Premises or personal property resulting from the furnishing of services or equipment on such Premises or the installation or removal thereof;
- 2.3.4.J Any wrongful act of a Company employee where such act is not authorized by the Company and is not within the scope of the employee's responsibilities for the Company;
- 2.3.4.K Any non-completed calls due to network busy conditions; and
- 2.3.4.L Any calls not actually attempted to be completed during any period that service is unavailable.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.3 Limitations of Liability (Cont'd)

- 2.3.5 The User shall reimburse the Company for all costs, expenses and fees, including reasonable attorney's fees, incurred by the Company in its defense against claims set forth in Section 2.3.4.
- 2.3.6 The Company assumes no responsibility for the availability or performance of any facilities under the control of other entities that are used to provide service to the User, even if the Company has acted as the User's agent in arranging for such facilities or services.
- 2.3.7 With the exception of billing disputes, any claim against the Company shall be deemed waived unless presented to the Company upon discovery or as soon as possible upon discovery.
- 2.3.8 With respect to the services provided pursuant to this service guide, the Company makes no representations or warranties, express or implied, either in fact or by operation of law, statutory or otherwise, including, but not limited to, warranties of title or implied warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, except those expressly set forth in this service guide. The Company does not authorize anyone to make a warranty or representation of any kind on its behalf and the User should not rely on any such statement.
- 2.3.9 Any liability of the Company for loss or damages arising out of mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, errors or defects in the service, the transmission of the service, or failures or defects in facilities furnished by the Company, occurring in the course of furnishing service, in no event shall exceed an amount equivalent to the proportionate fixed monthly charge assessed on the Customer for the time period in which the service giving rise to the claim occurred.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.4 Responsibilities of the Customer

- 2.4.1 Customers may be required to enter into a written service order which shall contain or reference a specific description of the service ordered, the rates to be charged, the duration of the services and the terms and conditions in the service guides and tariffs of the Company. Customer also may be required to execute any other documents or provide information pertaining to past accounts for similar services as may be reasonably requested by the Company.
- 2.4.2 The Customer is responsible for placing any necessary orders, complying with the service guide and tariff regulations and assuring that Users comply with service guide and tariff regulations. The Customer shall ensure compliance with any applicable laws, regulations, orders or other requirements of any governmental entity relating to services provided by the Company to the Customer or made available by the Customer to another User. The Customer also is responsible for the payment of charges for all Calls originated at the Customer's numbers which are not collect, third party, calling card, or credit card calls.
- 2.4.3 At the expiration of the initial term specified in each Service Order, or any extension thereof, service shall continue on a month to month basis at the then current rates unless terminated by either party. Any termination shall not relieve Customer of its obligation to pay any charges incurred under the service order and the service guides and tariffs of the Company prior to termination. The rights and obligations which by their nature extend beyond the termination of the service shall survive such termination.
- 2.4.4 When a Customer cancels an application for service prior to the start of service or prior to any special construction, no charges will be imposed except as follows: where the Company has notified a Customer or prospective Customer of the possibility that special expenses may be incurred in connection with provisioning their services, and then the company does incur such expenses. Expenses could include special construction or where special arrangements of facilities or equipment have begun before the company received a cancellation notice. The charge will be equal to the costs actually incurred, less net salvage.
- 2.4.5 If required for the provisioning of the Company's services, the Customer must provide the Company, free of charge, with any necessary equipment space, supporting structure, conduit and electrical power.
- 2.4.6 The Customer is responsible for arranging access to its Premises at times mutually agreeable to the Company and the Customer when required for Company personnel to install, repair, maintain, program, inspect or remove equipment associated with the provision of the Company's services.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.4 Responsibilities of the Customer (Cont'd)

2.4.7 The Customer must pay the Company for replacement or repair of damage to the Company's equipment or facilities caused by negligent or improper use on the part of the Customer, Users, or others.

2.4.8 The Customer must indemnify the Company for the theft of any Company equipment or facilities installed at the Customer's Premises.

2.4.9 The Customer agrees to release, indemnify and hold harmless the Company against any and all loss, claims, demands, suits or other action or any liability whatsoever, whether suffered, made, instituted or asserted by the Customer or by any other party or person, for any personal injury to or death of any person or persons, or for any loss of or damage to any property, whether owned by the Customer or others. The Customer shall reimburse the Company for all costs, expenses and fees, including reasonable attorneys' fees, incurred by the Company in its defense against such actions.

2.5 Allowances for Interruptions in Service

2.5.1 General

2.5.1.A Pursuant to MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16(A), the Company shall make an adjustment in accordance with MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16(B) whenever a subscriber's service is interrupted and remains out of service for more than twenty-four consecutive hours after being reported to the Company or after being found to be out of service.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.5 Allowances for Interruptions in Service (Cont'd)

2.5.2 Application of Credits for Interrupted Services

- 2.5.2.A As required by MTSS 4901:1-5-16(B), if an out service condition exceeds twenty-four hours, but is less than forty-eight hours, the Company shall credit the subscriber's bill for at least the pro rata portion of the monthly charge(s) for all regulated local services rendered inoperative during the interruption. Credit for out-of-service conditions lasting longer shall be provided pursuant to MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16(B)(1)-(3).
- 2.5.2.B Credits for failure to install new service in a timely manner shall be applied pursuant to MISS 4901:1-5-16(D).
- 2.5.2.C Credits for missed appointments shall be applied pursuant to MTSS 4901:1-5-16(E).
- 2.5.2.D Credits for failure to include a subscriber's listing in the white pages of the telephone directory or to correctly list a subscriber's telephone number shall be applied pursuant to MTSS 4901:1-5-16(F).
- 2.5.2.E Adjustments for overcharges or undercharges by the Company shall be made in accordance with MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16(G).

2.5.3 Limitations on Allowances

- 2.5.3.A No credit allowance will be made for any interruption of service resulting from any of the acts or conditions listed in MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16(A)(1)-(4) and (C).

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.6 Termination of Service

- 2.6.1 A Customer may terminate service, with or without cause, by giving the Company notice, except where cause must be provided pursuant to the Customer's contract or Service Order. If a Customer orders services requiring special equipment and/or facilities dedicated to the Customer's use and then cancels the order before the service begins, a charge will be made to the Customer for the non-recoverable portions of expenditures or liabilities incurred expressly on behalf of the Customer by the Company.
- 2.6.2 Pursuant to MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(A), local service may only be disconnected for subscriber nonpayment of charges regulated by the Commission.
- 2.6.3 Toll Services may be disconnected for subscriber nonpayment of toll service, subjected to the conditions listed in MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(B).
- 2.6.4 Pursuant to MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(D), the Company shall notify, or attempt to notify through any reasonable means, a subscriber before service is refused or disconnected when any of the following conditions exist:
 - 2.6.4.A a violation of the Company's service guides and tariffs on file with the Commission;
 - 2.6.4.B failure to comply with municipal ordinances or other laws pertaining to telecommunications services; or
 - 2.6.4.C a refusal by the subscriber to permit the local service provider access to its facilities. Pursuant to MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(F), the Company shall not disconnect the local or toll service of a subscriber who pays the Company the total amount due (or an amount agreed upon between the Company and subscriber) on his/her account by the close of business on the disconnection date listed on the disconnection notice.
- 2.6.5 Service may be disconnected without prior notice for any of the reasons listed under MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(G).

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.6 Termination of Service (Cont'd)

- 2.6.6 Pursuant to MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(K), a subscriber's bill shall not be due earlier than 14 days from the date of the postmark on the bill. If the bill is not paid by the due date, the Company shall not disconnect the service: (a) sooner than 14 days after the bill's due date and (b) without sending a written notice of disconnection, postmarked at least seven (7) days prior to the date of service disconnection. Service may be disconnected only during normal business hours; however, no disconnection for past due bills may be made after 12:30 p.m. on the day preceding a day that all services necessary for reconnection are not available.
- 2.6.7 In compliance with MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(M), absent circumstances beyond the Company's control or a request by the subscriber, the Company shall reconnect previously disconnected service by 5 p.m on the next business day following: (a) receipt by the Company of the full amount in arrears for which the service was disconnected, or upon verification by the Company that conditions which warranted disconnection have been eliminated; or (b) agreement by the Company and the subscriber on a deferred payment plan and a payment, if required, under the plan.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.7 Payment of Charges

- 2.7.1 The Customer is responsible for payment of all charges for service furnished by the Company to the Customer and Users, regardless of whether those services are used by the Customer itself or are resold to or shared with other persons. The Company's invoices and billing practices will comply with MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-15
- 2.7.2 Recurring monthly charges may be invoiced one month in advance. Invoicing cycles are approximately thirty (30) days in length, and payment is due 14 days from bill postmark date. Payment will be considered timely if paid within twenty (20) days of the billing date. After twenty (20) days, payment will be considered late.
- 2.7.3 The Company reserves the right to assess late payment charges for Customers whose account(s) carries principal owing from the prior billing period. Any charges not paid in full by the due date indicated on the billing statement may be subject to a late fee of 1.5% per month.
- 2.7.4 Customers must notify the Company either verbally or in writing of any disputed charges upon discovery and as soon as possible, otherwise all charges on the invoice will be deemed accepted. All charges remain due and payable at the due date, although a Customer is not required to pay any disputed charges during the time period in which the Company conducts its investigation into the matter.
- 2.7.5 In the event of a dispute concerning a bill, Customers must pay a sum equal to the amount of the undisputed portion of the bill and proceed with the complaint procedures set forth in this service guide.

2.8 Deposits

The Company will not require deposits from Customers. Pursuant to MTSS Rule 13, however, prospective customers required to establish creditworthiness may avail themselves of the methods identified in that rule (and by reference in Chapters 4901:1-5 and 4901:1-17 of the Administrative Code), which include submission of a deposit pursuant to subsection 4901:1-5-13(B)(2)(a) ("the individual service history method") representing 230% of the customer's known or estimated monthly charge for local services calculated consistent with that section.

2.9 Advance Payments

The Company will not require advance payments from Customers.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.10 Contested Charges

All bills are presumed accurate, and shall be binding on the Customer unless objection is received by the Company upon discovery or as soon as possible, either verbally or in writing. In the event that a billing dispute between the Customer and the Company for service furnished to the Customer cannot be settled with mutual satisfaction, the Customer may take the following course of action:

2.10.1 First, the Customer may request, and the Company will provide, an in-depth review of the disputed amount. (The undisputed portion and subsequent bills must be paid on a timely basis or the service may be subject to disconnection.)

2.10.2 Second, if there is still a disagreement about the disputed amount after investigation and review by the Company, the Customer may file an appropriate complaint with the Ohio Public Utilities Commission . The address of the Commission is:

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.11 Transfers and Assignments

Neither the Company nor the Customer may assign or transfer its rights or duties in connection with the Services and facilities provided by the Company without the written consent of the other party, except that the Company may assign its rights and duties (a) to any subsidiary, parent company or affiliate of the Company, (b) pursuant to any sale or transfer of substantially all the assets of the Company, or (c) pursuant to any financing, merger or reorganization of the Company.

2.12 Temporary Promotional Programs

The Company may establish temporary promotional programs under which it may waive or reduce non-recurring or recurring charges, to introduce present or potential Customers to a Service not previously received by the Customers. The specific terms of each promotional program shall be filed with the Commission within 30 days of its effective date.

2.13 Application of Rates

2.13.1 Introduction

The regulations set forth in this Section govern the application of rates for services contained in Section 4 and 5 of the service guides of the Company.

2.13.2 Rates Based on Duration of Use

Where charges for a service are specified based on the duration of use, such as the duration of a telephone call, the following rules apply:

- a. Unless otherwise specified, calls are timed in one minute increments. All calls which are fractions of a measurement increment are rounded-up to the next whole unit.
- b. Timing on completed calls begins when the call is answered by the called party. Answering is determined by hardware answer supervision in all cases where this signaling is provided by the terminating local carrier and any intermediate carrier(s).

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.14 Application of Rates (Cont'd)

2.14.2 Rates Based on Duration of Use (Cont'd)

- c. Timing terminates on all calls when the calling party hangs up or the Company's network receives an on-hook signal from the terminating carrier.

2.13.3 Rates Based Upon Distance

Where charges for a service are specified based upon distance, the following rules apply:

- a. Distance between two points is measured as airline distance between the Rate Centers of the originating and terminating telephone lines. The Rate Center is a set of geographic coordinates, as referenced in National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. Tariff FCC No. 4, associated with each NPA-NXX combination (where NPA is the area code and NXX is the first three digits of a seven-digit telephone number). Where there is no telephone number associated with an access line on the Company's network (such as a dedicated access line), the Company will apply the Rate Center of the Customer's main billing telephone number.
- b. The airline distance between any two Rate Centers is determined as follows:
 - 1) Obtain the "V" (vertical) and "H" (horizontal) coordinates for each Rate Center from the above-referenced NECA tariff.
 - 2) Compute the difference between the "V" coordinates of the two rate centers; and the difference between the two "H" coordinates.
 - 3) Square each difference obtained in step (2) above.
 - 4) Add the square of the "V" difference and the square of the difference obtained in step (3) above.
 - 5) Divide the sum of the squares by 10. Round to the next higher whole number if any fraction is obtained.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.14 Application of Rates (Cont'd)

2.13.4 Flexible Pricing

2.13.4.A General

Flexible Pricing sets maximum rates that can be charged for telephone service. The Company may change a specific rate within the range of the established maximum rates on one day's notice to customers and the Public Utilities Commission .

2.13.4.B Conditions

2.13.4.B.1 The Company reserves the right to change prices at any time subject to regulatory requirements by filing a revised Rate Attachment with the Commission.

2.13.4.B.2 Individual written notice to Customers of rate changes shall be made in accordance with Commission regulations. Where there are no regulations, notification will be made in a manner appropriate to the circumstances involved.

2.13.4.B.3 A rate shall not be changed unless it has been in effect for at least thirty (30) days.

2.13.4.B.4 A Customer can request that the Company disconnect service that is provided under the Flexible Pricing due to a price increase. The Customer will be credited for the difference for the new price and the old price retroactive to the effective date of the price increase if the Customer notifies the Company of its desire to disconnect service within 20 days of receiving notification of the price increase.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.14 Timing of Calls

- 2.14.1 The Customer's monthly usage charges for the Company service are based upon the total number of minutes the Customer uses and the service options to which the Customer subscribes. Chargeable time begins at the time the called party answers (i.e. when two-way communications is possible), and ends when either party hangs up.
- 2.14.2 No charges apply if a Call is not completed.
- 2.14.3 For billing purposes, all Calls are rounded up to the nearest minute and billed in increments of one minute. The minimum Call duration is one (1) minute for a connected Call.
- 2.14.4 Where applicable, charges will be rounded up to the nearest penny.
- 2.14.5 Usage begins when the called party picks up the receiver (i.e. when two-way communication is possible). A Call is terminated when the calling or called party hangs up. The Company utilizes software answer supervision, which permits up to sixty (60) seconds of ringing before the Call becomes billed usage. Where answer supervision is not available, any Call for which the duration exceeds sixty (60) seconds shall be presumed to have been answered and becomes billed usage.
- 2.14.6 The Company will not knowingly charge for Incomplete or unanswered Calls. Upon the Customer's request and proper verification, the Company shall promptly adjust or credit the Customer's account for charges or payments for any Incomplete or unanswered Call inadvertently billed due to the unavailability of Feature Group D or due to another carrier's failure to provide answer supervision. Upon the Customer's request and proper verification, the Company also shall promptly adjust or credit the Customer's account for charges or payments for Calls placed to a wrong number.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

2.15 Start of Billing

For billing purposes, the start of service is the day following acceptance by the Customer of the Company's service or equipment, or another date mutually agreed-upon by the Customer and the Company. The end of service date is the last day of the minimum notification of cancellation or any portion of the last day, after receipt by the Company of notification of cancellation, or another date mutually agreed-upon by the Customer and the Company.

2.16 Minimum Call Completion Rate

The Customer may expect a Call completion rate of at least ninety-percent (90%) of dialed, local interoffice calls attempted during peak use periods or the busy hour.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

3.1 General Service Information

The Company offers local exchange telecommunications services to Customers throughout the State of Ohio. The services outlined in this Service Guide supplement the services found in the Company's P.U.C.O. Tariff No. 3, currently on file with the Commission.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES (Cont'd)

3.2 Local Exchange Services

3.2.1.A Private Branch Exchange (PBX)

The Company's PBX Service uses PBX trunks to connect a customer PBX system or other similar equipment to the Company Central Office. Company treats these trunks similar to individual exchange lines and supports multi-line hunting over a group of trunks.

3.2.1.B Direct Inward Dialing Service

Direct Inward Dialing ("DID") Service is an optional feature provided in conjunction with Company-provided PBX Trunks. DID Service permits incoming calls from the exchange network to reach a specific station line without the assistance of an attendant through the use of a seven digit number. DID service transmits the dialed digits for all incoming calls allowing the Customer's PBX to route incoming calls directly to individual stations corresponding to each individual DID number. DID is furnished upon the condition that the customer contract for adequate facilities, e.g., dial tone lines, circuit packs or equivalent, etc, to permit the use of the service without injurious effect on general telephone service. Certain conditions, such as transmission limitations, may require the provision of additional switching equipment on the customer's premises in order to furnish DID service. The Company offers DID services to Customers in minimum blocks of telephone numbers.

3.2.1.C Centrex Services

Centrex Service provides the Customer with multiple individual voice-grade telephone communications channels, each of which can be used to place or receive one call at a time. Centrex Station Lines are provided for connection of Centrex-compatible Customer-provided station sets to the public switched telecommunications network. Each Centrex Station Line may be provided in combination with other Company-provided services including PBX and ISDN.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES (Cont'd)

3.2 Local Exchange Services (Cont'd)

3.2.2 Local Calling Services (Cont'd)

3.2.1.D Hunting Service

Hunting Services are optional arrangement available to Customers with two or more line services at the same location, same system. Where facilities permit, lines are arranged so that incoming calls to a busy line overflow to another line in the hunting arrangement. The Company may also offer a hunting service that is activated by the end user.

3.2.1.E Centrex Pilot

Pilot or lead line of the hunt group for Centranet.

3.2.1.F Foreign Exchange Service

Foreign Exchange (FX) Service provides for the connection of a Customer's location to a central office serving an exchange area, within the Customer's LATA, other than the exchange area in which the Customer is located.

3.2.1.G CentraNet Service

CentraNet Service is a local exchange telecommunications service available to customers served from suitably equipped central offices. It is an arrangement which consists of host central office interface equipment and software located on Company premises. A system may not be provided for stand alone service only and access to the Company's exchange network must be provided by the Company.

If remote units are required to provide switching capabilities for intracomunications purposes, they will be located on Company provided sites located on the customer's premises. Any remote units and all system cabling used in association with CentraNet Service are provided by and remain the property of the Company. Feature capabilities may vary depending on the type of host central office equipment.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES (Cont'd)

3.2 Local Exchange Services (Cont'd)

3.2.2 Local Calling Plans

3.2.2.A Basic Business Package

This package includes Caller I.D. number display, Caller I.D. Name Display, Call Waiting, Call Forward Standard or Variable, Three Way Calling, Auto Call Back (*69 for last number that called).

3.2.2.B Flexline Service Basic Package

Flexline Service Basic is an access line for low volume use that operates independently of the end user's other telephone lines. The end user can place calls from the Flexline Service Basic, but calls do not overflow from the end user's regular line to the Flexline. Flexline Service Basic is independent of the end user's other service. The line is available to receive or make calls, but does not automatically ring if the end user's other line(s) is in use.

3.2.2.C Flexline Service Plus

Flexline Service Plus is an access line that operates as an overflow line for incoming calls. It is available for incoming calls. It is available for outgoing calls when the end user's regular line is engaged. A Busy Line Transfer is activated in the main line (or last line in a hunt group) to forward calls to the Flexline Service Plus when the regular lines are in use.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES (Cont'd)

3.2 Local Exchange Services (Cont'd)

3.2.3 Local Calling Plans (Cont'd)

3.2.2.D Loyalty Rewards Program I

The Loyalty Rewards Program I provides Customers with basic local service and custom calling features for a flat fee. Loyalty Rewards Program I Customers receive unlimited local calling and all local vertical features such as Caller ID, Call Waiting and Call Forwarding. The Program or accompanying fee does not include or apply to local usage, intraLATA toll charges, Remote Call Forwarding, Off Premises Extensions, WIRE-PRO, PBX, ISDN, Foreign Exchange Number and federal and local fees, taxes or surcharges, including local number portability.

3.2.2.E Loyalty Rewards Program II

The Loyalty Rewards Program II provides Customers with basic local service and custom calling features for a flat fee. Loyalty Rewards Program II Customers receive metered local calling and all local vertical features such as Caller ID, Call Waiting and Call Forwarding. The Program and accompanying fee do not include or apply to local usage, intraLATA charges, Remote Call Forwarding, Off Premises Extensions, WIRE-PRO, PBX, ISDN, Foreign Exchange Number and federal and local fees, taxes or surcharges, including local number portability. Customers must have at least \$200.00 in long distance services from the most recent invoice to qualify for the Loyalty Rewards Program II service offering.

3.2.2.F Loyalty Rewards Program III

The Loyalty Rewards Program III provides Customers with basic local service and custom calling features for a flat fee. Loyalty Rewards Program III Customers receive metered local calling and all local vertical features such as Caller ID, Call Waiting and Call Forwarding. The Program and accompanying fee does not include or apply to local usage, intraLATA charges, Remote Call Forwarding, Off Premises Extensions, WIRE-PRO, PBX, ISDN, Foreign Exchange Number and federal and local fees, taxes or surcharges, including local number portability.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES (Cont'd)

3.3 ISDN Services

National Integrated Services Digital Network (ISDN) Direct is a telecommunications service that provides an integrated voice/data communications capability for the transmission of circuit switched voice and data and packet switched data signals on an incoming and outgoing basis utilizing Integrated Services Digital network architecture.

3.3.1 ISDN Primary Rate Interface (PRI)

Service provides the Business Customer with a direct digital connection, via switched access, to one or more public and/or private services. The service arranges the 64 Kbps channels of a DS1 into 23 B (Bearer) channels and 1 D (Delta) channel or 24 B channels under control of a D channel residing on a separate PRI facility. The B channels carry voice and data traffic at speeds up to 64 Kbps. The D channel carries the out-of-band signaling required to control its associated B channels.

3.3.2 Individual Line Business ISDN Basic Rate Interface (BRI)

Service is an optional service arrangement which can be used in conjunction with a customer's Individual Line Business service. It uses the ISDN architecture to provide the customer with the capabilities of simultaneous access, transmission and switching of voice, data and imaging services via channelized transport. Service provides two bearer B-channels at 64 Kbps per second and a data D-channel at 16 Kbps per second. The bearer B-channels are designed for PCM voice, video conferencing, group 4 facsimile machines, etc. The data D-channel is for bringing in information about incoming calls and taking out information about outgoing calls.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES (Cont'd)

3.4 Channel Services

3.4.1 General Description

Channel Service consists of two-point or multi-point communications service offerings usually dedicated solely to the use of a particular Customer. Channels are electrical path utilized for transmitting signals, voice, or data communications. Channels are derived in such a manner as the Company may elect and are suitable for the purposes for which they are furnished. While it is contemplated that the Customer may provide the terminal apparatus and wiring (exclusive of the equipment necessary to derive and terminate the channel which is provided by the Company), at the request of the Customer and provided that request is reasonable, termination equipment will be provided by the Company subject to the rates and regulations set forth herein.

Facilities, consisting of channels, termination and arrangements are classified by Series and further classified within each Series by Type. The various Series and Types are described in terms of characteristics and use.

3.4.2 Channel Termination

This service allows end users to choose multiple points for termination for a single channel.

3.4.2.A CO Loop Chg – 2 Wire

Provides two channel terminations either in the same wire center, or in different serving wire centers connected by an interoffice channel.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES (Cont'd)

3.5 Operator Services

Local calls may be completed or billed with the live or mechanical assistance by the Company's operator center. Calls may be billed collect to the called party, to an authorized 3rd party number, to the originating line, or to a valid authorized calling card. Local calls may be placed on a station to station basis or to a specified party (see Person to Person), or designated alternate. Usage charges for local operator assisted calls are those usage charges that would normally apply to the calling party's service.

Provides for live or automated operator treatment when Customer dials "0". Services include, but are not limited to, bill to originating telephone number, calling card, collect or to a third party:

- 3.5.1 Collect Calls - Calls where the called person agrees to pay for the call. Company offers two types of collect calls.
- 3.5.2 Person-to-Person - Calls completed with the assistance of a Company operator to a particular person, station, department or PBX extension specified by the calling party.
- 3.5.3 Station-to-Station - Operator assisted calls other than Person-to-Person billed to either the Business Customer's phone number, or the end user's calling card. Calls may be dialed with or without assistance of a Company operator.
- 3.5.4 Third Party Billed Cards - Calls where the customer requests that the phone call be charged to a third party's phone number. If the originating caller is calling from a payphone, the third party number is called. The third party has to answer the phone and accept the charges before the operator completes the call.
- 3.5.5 Toll Billing Exception. Operator call screen on inbound toll.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES (Cont'd)

3.6 Message Telecommunications Service/Toll Services

Message Telecommunications Service or Toll Service is a communications service which is available for use by Customers twenty-four (24) hours a day. MTS enables a User of an exchange access line to place calls to any station on the public switched telephone network bearing an NPS-NXX designation associated with points outside the Customer's Local Calling Area, but within the boundaries of home LATA.

3.6.1 Toll Free Service

A call to a station outside the subscribers local calling area for which the called party pays instead of the calling party.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES (Cont'd)

3.7 Custom Calling Features

- 3.7.1 Call Forwarding: Permits the Customer to forward calls to any telephone number or station in the Customer Group that their station is allowed to call, including voicemail and attendant. This feature may also include the ability to activate from a remote location.
- 3.7.2 Call Forwarding No Answer: Permits the forwarding of incoming calls when the End-User's line remains unanswered after end user designated number of rings. The number of rings and the forwarded number are fixed by the Customer service order.
- 3.7.3 Call Forwarding – Speed: This is a two feature package that includes Call Forwarding and Speed Dial.
- 3.7.4 Call Forwarding Variable: Permits the end-user to automatically forward (transfer) all incoming calls to an end-user designated telephone number and permits the end-user to restore incoming calls to non-Call Forwarding operations. The Customer is charged for the call between the original terminating number and the number to which it is remotely call forwarded. The Customer must subscribe to adequate facilities to permit the use of the service without impairment, disruption or deterioration of the quality of other telephone services.
- 3.7.5 Call Transfer: Allows the User to transfer a Call to another station within the Customer Group or to an outside telephone number.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES (Cont'd)

3.8 Custom Calling Features (Cont'd)

- 3.7.6 Distinctive Ringing: This feature allows a Customer to have several telephone numbers which consist of the main telephone number and a maximum number of additional telephone numbers, associated with one exchange access line. Each telephone number will have a distinctive ring on incoming calls to allow the Customer to identify the incoming call line. All telephone lines must be served by the same Central Office.
- 3.7.7 Multi-line Value Package: A service package that includes: custom business features.
- 3.7.8 Multi-line Value Package – Call Forwarding: A service package that includes: custom business features with call forwarding.
- 3.7.9 Multi-line Value Package – Alternating Answer: A service package that includes: custom business features with call forward no answer .
- 3.7.10 Multi-line Value Package – Call Forwarding: A service package that includes: custom business features with Call Waiting.
- 3.7.11 Remote Call Forwarding/Remote Line Service: An automatic reverse charge exchange service which provides for a Customer to arrange that Customers in the same or a different exchange may call him/her without paying the toll charge between a specified exchange and the Customer's location or asking the operator to assist with or complete the call.
- 3.7.12 Smarter Package: A customer calling package that features Call Forwarding, Call Waiting, Speed Calling 8 and Three-Way Calling.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES (Cont'd)

3.8 Custom Calling Features (Cont'd)

- 3.7.13 Speed Calling (8 or 30): Permits the Customer to place calls to other telephone numbers by dialing a one- or two-digit code rather than complete telephone numbers. The feature is available as an eight code list or a thirty code list. Either code list may include local and/or toll telephone numbers. To establish or change a telephone number in a code list, the Customer dials an activating code, receives a second dial tone and dials either a one- or two-digit code (for the eight code and thirty code lists, respectively) plus the telephone number.
- 3.7.14 Voice Mail: Provides an audio mailbox to record, store, retrieve, review, save and handle audio messages for Customers. The service will greet incoming customers with a personal or standard greeting, and provide audio prompts and personal security codes for Customers and Users of Service. Additional message capacity for the voice mail box may be purchased.
- 3.7.15 NOS Voice Mail Features Package: This service includes Message Waiting Indication, Busy Line Transfer, Alternate Answer and Star Code Access to voice mail service. Message waiting indication provides for a visual and audible signal to be activated on a Network Access Line. Busy Line Transfer automatically transfers incoming calls to alternate designated exchange telephone numbers or to a DID Station Number when the called number is busy. Alternate Answering automatically transfers incoming calls that encounter a do not answer condition after a predetermined number of rings to a designated exchange telephone number or to a DID Station Number. Star Code Access to a voice mail service is abbreviated dialing access to voice mail from the customer premises via an abbreviated code (* and a two-digit code). The NOS Voice Mail Features package is available where facilities permit. It is offered only in association with residence and business exchange services and unless specified otherwise, PBX trunks. NOS Voice Mail Features package is not available with Centrex system stations, semi-public service or party line exchange service.

7.5.3 Ohio Zones of Wheeling Area Exchange Area

a. Description

The Wheeling Area Exchange Area consists of three zones located in Ohio, and four zones located in West Virginia and operated by the Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company of West Virginia, as follows:

b. Messages Between Zones

All messages from stations of each of the Ohio zones to other stations of the Wheeling Area Exchange Area are considered to be local messages.

c. Foreign Zone Service

1) Where exchange service is furnished to a customer located in a zone within Ohio through a central office of a zone within Ohio other than that regularly serving the zone in which the customer is located, the regulations, rates and charges for foreign central office service are applicable.

2) Where exchange service is furnished to a customer in an Ohio zone through a central office in a West Virginia zone or to a customer in a West Virginia zone through a central office in an Ohio zone, the portion of the facilities in Ohio are furnished as covered in 3-a above. For the portion of the facilities located in West Virginia, charges apply as specified in the intrastate tariff of The Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company of West Virginia.

d. All other circuits and Channels

1) Where the terminals of the circuit or channel are located in Ohio and in the same or in different zones, circuit rates apply as specified for circuits or channels "within the same exchange area".

2) Where the terminals of the circuit or channel are located in a zone in Ohio and in a zone in West Virginia, the provisions of 4-a above apply to the portion of the facilities in Ohio for the portion of the facilities in West Virginia, charges apply as specified in the intrastate tariff of The Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company of West Virginia.

e. In the application of rates and charges for other items of service included in this service guide, the Local Exchange Tariff or the Private Line Service Tariff and with respect to the application of message toll telephone service rates, or any other matter covered by any other telephone Company tariff, the terms "zone" and "zone area" as used in this paragraph have the same meaning as the terms "exchange" and "exchange area".

SECTION 8 - PROMOTIONAL, SPECIAL SERVICES AND TELECOMPETITIVE SERVICE OFFERINGS

8.1 General Description

From time to time, Company shall publish rates or select published or tariffed rates, the purpose of and/or design for which is to retain Company's competitive position by offering rates which are necessitated by competing offers received by or available to existing or potential customers, which, if not matched or bettered, would result in the loss of an existing or potential customer and/or in the reduction of traffic volume of the customer. Company either shall require customer confirmation of the competitive offer in writing or shall confirm the availability of a more favorable competitive rate from published tariffs, service guides, marketing materials, or other public sources to establish a customer's right to obtain a Promotional, Special Service and/or Telecompetitive Service offering.

SECTION 8 – PROMOTIONAL, SPECIAL SERVICES AND TELECOMPETITIVE SERVICE OFFERINGS (Cont'd)

8.2 Customer Loyalty Plan

Customers who qualify as either a "save" or a "winback" and who meet the eligibility requirements set forth herein will receive a credit on either their 4th, 6th or 9th invoice as selected by Customer upon service initiation and as provided following.

8.2.1 For each three, five or eight invoices (for credit months 4, 6 and 9, respectively) of consecutive uninterrupted service, a credit shall be calculated equal to the lower of either (i) the average of the Customer's monthly charges excluding fees, taxes, surcharges, assessments, and similar charges ("eligible charges"), for the preceding consecutive eight-month period; or (ii) a credit which equals the eligible charges on the invoice in which the credit is applied.

8.2.2 To be eligible for the 4th, 6th or 9th invoice free bonus, each Customer must:

8.2.2.A have initiated service;

8.2.2.B have no record of nonpayment in any of the preceding consecutive twelve-month period of service;

8.2.2.C have received eight consecutive and uninterrupted invoices over the preceding eight-month period;

8.2.2.D have selected the 9th invoice free bonus incentive prior to the first day in the period of service covered by Customer's ninth invoice; and

8.2.2.E pay all charges rendered in Customer's ninth invoice in excess of the amount of the applicable credit as calculated preceding.

8.2.3

Beginning July 15, 2006, customers receiving a credit under the "Every Fourth Invoice Free" Customer Loyalty Plan, will have the "Every Fourth Invoice Free" Customer Loyalty Plan removed from their accounts, and will have the "Every Ninth Invoice Free" Customer Loyalty Plan added to their accounts in substitution. For purposes of calculating when a customer will receive a credit under the newly substituted "Every Ninth Invoice Free" Customer Loyalty Plan, the Company will begin the calculation with the customer's first invoice following the last credit invoice under the "Every Fourth Invoice Free" Customer Loyalty Plan.
